Jan Lord

"Creating harmony, warmth and a reflection of life itself is my goal." Every painting that I create is done with the intention of providing the viewer with joy and happiness. Each painting reflects my love of life and nature. While my instincts guide me to be more conservative with my creations, my free spirit takes over and my art develops into something more bold and creative than I would have imagined.

Born and raised in Canada, Jan studied art from the time she was in grade school. In the summer months during her childhood, she could be found painting in the beautiful parks of Vancouver B.C. Throughout her career, she has studied with a variety of Canadian and American watercolor and acrylic artists. Through these instructors, Jan has found her own totally unique style.


Techniques include acrylic, oil pastels, glazing and adding a variety of elements such as aluminum, graphite, paper, iron, nuts and bolts on wood panels. Jan's true inspiration comes from music. The rhythm and words will have an emotional effect that transforms into vibrant colors, abstract shapes and images. Her mixed media works are known for their layered color fields and heavily textured surfaces. Photographs do not do justice to the level of intricacy and detailing.

Acrylic, oil stick, oils, graphite, glaze, metal, paper and corrugated cardboard are incorporated to give each painting its depth, layers and interest. All 2.5" thick wood panels are constructed and well reinforced with Baltic Birch and Douglas Fir. These panels have been designed to be sturdy yet relatively light weight for their size.

The words, sayings and quotations on each piece of art, relate to memorable lyrics or tunes from musicians and poets who have touched Jan's life. Whether it is the era, time and place the song was written, or the tunes themselves - each lends a particular inspiration to her art. Numbers and random letters are related to "lucky" numbers and symbols. Jan credits her Scottish background for this "Old Country" superstition.

Her intention is to engage the viewer with words, images and colors that may trigger in them, an emotion or memory of a special time or place in their life, much like a piece of music evokes that same nostalgia. As their eyes wander across the artwork, Jan hopes to invoke individual reflection and wonderful feelings, much like each song does for her. Creating harmony, composition, color and rhythm is vital to a piece, yet often unintentionally, people or "strangers" will appear in her paintings. Jan welcomes these guests when they emerge by prominently outlining them, so they become more visible.




